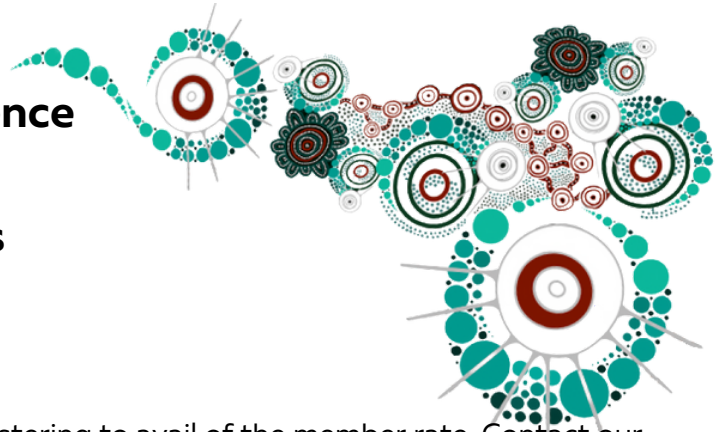

Registrations Terms & Conditions



Member registrations

You must be a current NAATSIHWP member before registering to avail of the member rate. Contact our membership team at membership@naatsihwp.org.au for more details on becoming a NAATSIHWP member or to check your current membership details.

Early bird registrations

Early bird registrations open 18 July 2022 and have been extended to 31 August 2022. Early bird registrations must be paid in full prior to the close of the early bird registration period for the discounted rate to apply. If you are paying by invoice, please ensure that the payment is processed during this period or your registration amount will automatically increase to the standard rate.

Standard registrations

Standard registrations open will close 30 September 2022. Any registration received after this day may incur a late processing fee and will be accepted at our discretion and according to event availability. All registrations must be paid in full prior to the start of the conference.

Welcome and Gala Dinner registrations

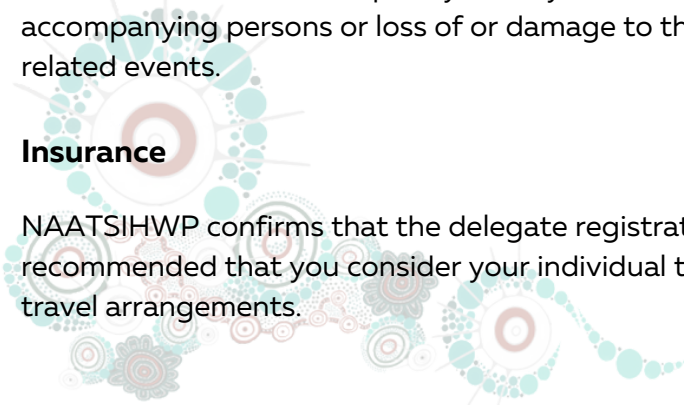

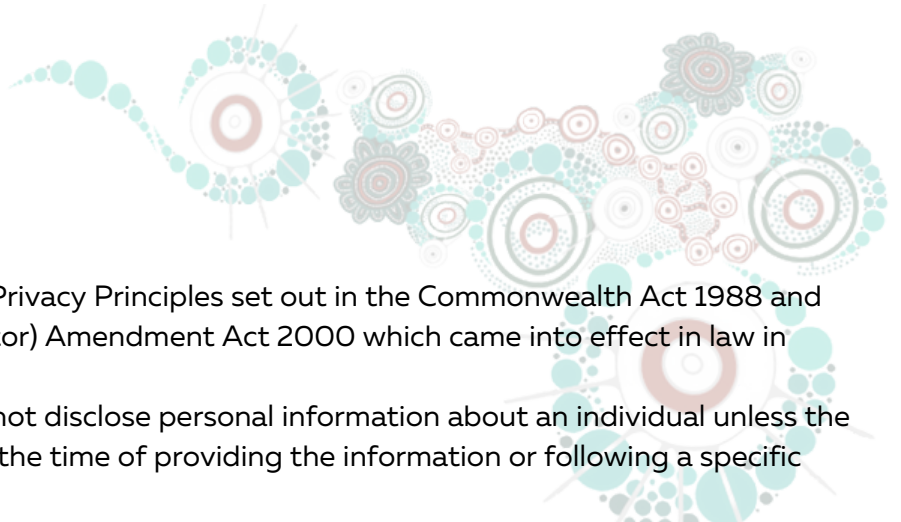
Disclaimer of liability

NAATSIHWP confirms that the delegate registration fees do not in any way include insurance cover. It is recommended that you consider your individual travel and health insurance requirements prior to making travel arrangements.





Privacy

NAATSIHWP complies with the National Privacy Principles set out in the Commonwealth Act 1988 and reaffirmed in the Privacy Act (Private Sector) Amendment Act 2000 which came into effect in law in December 2001.

Unless required by law, NAATSIHWP will not disclose personal information about an individual unless the individual has provided consent, either at the time of providing the information or following a specific request.

In registering for this conference, your relevant details will be included on a delegate list which will be distributed to all delegates, sponsors and exhibitors and conference organisers. Please advise us during the registration process if you do not consent for your details to be included on the delegate list.

Travel Arrangements

All travel-related bookings such as flights, transfers, accommodations etc is the responsibility of the delegate.

Media and photography

In registering for this conference you accept that various events at the conference and satellite events may be photographed, video or audio recorded and that this content may be used by NAATSIHWP at its discretion on website, social media, newsletters or other promotional material. Further information and permission on this will be outlined in the registration form.

Payment

All amounts are in Australian dollars and are inclusive for Goods and Services Tax (GST) of 10%. Payment may be made by credit card, subject to bank/merchant fees (Visa or Mastercard) or EFT. Credit card payment will be the only payment method accepted four weeks prior to the start of the conference. All registrations must be paid in full by 28 October.

Substitutions and Cancellations

Requests for cancellations and transfer of registrations must be submitted in writing via email to eso@naatsihwp.org.au.

- > Cancellation requests received up to 30 days prior to the event date will receive a refund of 75% of the registration costs.
- > Cancellations requests received after 30 days prior and before 14 days prior will receive a refund of 50% of the registration costs.
- > Cancellation requests received after 14 days prior to the event date will not be eligible for a refund.

Registrations can be transferred to other individuals within the same organisation at no cost (in the same registration category) up to 3 days prior to the start of the conference.



COVID-19
